

Rules to fly a drone in accordance to GCAA

Once registered with GCAA, you will:

1. Not fly the UA except for personal and pleasure use
2. Not fly the UA unless registered under the General Civil Aviation Authority
3. Not fly the UA beyond visual line of sight and more than 400 ft above the ground
4. Not fly the UA near the buildings, residential neighborhoods, public gatherings and public or private properties
5. Not fly the UA equipped with any kind of cameras, projection/dropping equipment or frequencies recording and laser
6. Not fly the UA carelessly or recklessly endangering the safety of others or properties
7. Not fly the UA at night
8. Not violate the UAE Civil Aviation Law or Regulations as published on the GCAA website www.gcaa.gov.ae
9. Mark the reference number of this Certificate on the Unmanned Aircraft
10. Fly the UA within the UAE allowed flying zones
11. Adhere to the minimum UA pilot age: 16 years for UA of less than 25Kg. & 21 years for UA of 25Kg. and above
